Begin your journey in Cape Town, the Mother City of South Africa, cradled by the imposing bulk of Table Mountain, Devil's Peak and Lion's Head. Highlights of the route includes a visit to the historic village of Matjiesfontein, an authentically preserved Victorian Village founded as a refreshment stop in 1890, which also boasts an impressive museum on the platform.

Another stop is made in Kimberley to visit the Diamond Mine Museum and the world's largest man-made excavation, the Big Hole.

Cape Town

For an opportunity to stroll through the historic village of special interest is the museum on the platform and a collection of historic cars and railway carriages to the right of the Lord Milner Hotel.

10:00 **The train travels through the Karoo**

A vast semi-desert region that was once an enormous inland sea. Over millions of years, volcanic matter was ground down and deposited as silt upon the seabed to form what geologists call the Karoo system.

13:00 **Lunch is served in the dining cars.**

16:30 **Tea in the lounge and observation cars.**

19:30 **Dinner is served in the dining cars.**
