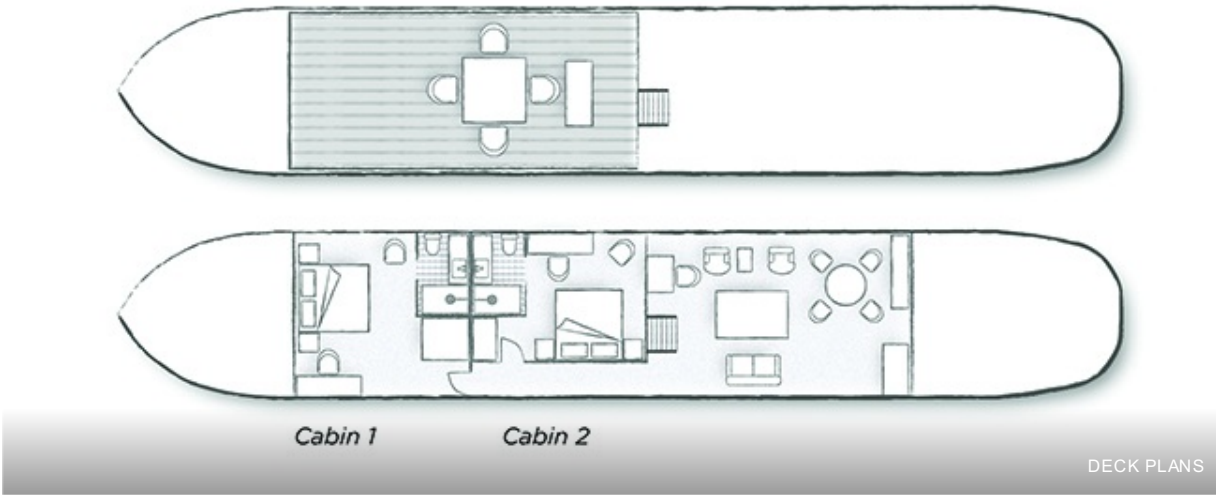
Welcome onboard!
